Civic Engagement

La Casa de Esperanza believes that civic engagement is an important part of fully participating in society. Voting and constituent participation are instrumental to democracy and irreplaceable in shaping good public policy that represents the values of all people. Therefore, La Casa supports policies and practices that invite civic participation and citizen input; and incorporate diversity in public appointments and leadership positions.

Economic Engagement

A vital part of La Casa's mission is to create opportunities for individuals to attain full economic participation in society. La Casa supports policies and practices that make it possible for all residents to achieve economic security and build assets. This can be accomplished by federal, state, and local policies that promote: 1) the development and skills of our workforce; 2) access to healthcare and health insurance; 3) a mixture of housing choices for all income levels; 4) a multi-modal transportation system; and 5) safe and affordable childcare for working parents.

Healthcare

La Casa believes that access to healthcare services and health insurance is essential to promote the health and well-being of our nation. We support federal and state policies that provide preventative health and dental care for all residents; ensure healthcare coverage for all children; and create avenues for all individuals to have affordable health insurance.
