Ways to Work (a family loan program) and La Casa de Esperanza Inc. have partnered up to help low income families with their transportation needs by offering small loans. Loans must be used either for a vehicle purchase or the repair (s) of a vehicle already owned. A client may borrow up to \$4,000.00 for a purchase and \$1,000.00 for repairs (consideration given for value of car). The repayment period is up to two years. To be considered for a loan, certain eligibility requirements must be met.

A client must be:

- **At least 18 years of age**
- **A resident of Waukesha County**
- **Employed at least 6 months**
- **Working 20 hours a week minimally**
- **Unable to get a standard car loan**
- **An involved parent of dependent child(ren)**
- **A valid driver's license holder**
- **Able and willing to repay the loan**
- **Able to complete Financial Education**
- **In poor credit standing**
